# Health Administration Completion Program

## Who should pursue the health administration completion program?

The Bachelor of Science in Health Administration completion program builds on foundation courses in associate degree programs and even other four-year degree programs. Graduates will be prepared for managerial roles in the health care industry and admission to advanced degree programs such as the Master's in Business Administration (MBA) or the Master's in Health Administration (MHA).

## Why study health administration at Coastal Carolina University?

- Mounting complexities in the health care environment mandate that health care professionals possess appropriate educational preparation to advance to administrative positions.
- The Health Administration completion program builds on the knowledge gained in entry-level health professional programs and provides the advanced knowledge, values, and critical judgment skills needed to assume leadership and management roles in health care settings.
- All courses in the Health Administration completion program are delivered in a distance learning format using the Blackboard Learning Management system (high-speed internet access is required).
- Students enrolling in the program who have earned an Associate of Arts or Science (A.A. or A.S.) or a Bachelor of Arts or Science (B.A. or B.S.) from a regionally accredited institution will have the core curriculum requirements waived.
- Schedule tracks are available for full-time or part-time degree completion.
