## What does a history major study?

History is the analysis of change over time, and the entire past is the province of the inquiring history student. As one of the ancient disciplines, history defies modern categorization. Most place it in the humanities, but history is partly art, partly science, and some even call it a social science.

## Why study history at Coastal Carolina?

- The Waccamaw Center for Cultural and Historical Studies involves faculty, students, and the community in the rich heritage of the local area along the beautiful and historic Waccamaw River. Explorations include colonial life, slavery, the Revolutionary War, and the history of Myrtle Beach and the surrounding area. Students may participate through formal course work or independent study and avail themselves of the center's bountiful sources.
- Students may take part in internships in local museums and archives.
- Study abroad opportunities are available to Italy, Great Britain, France, and Ireland.
- Students can complete individual research projects with faculty. Recent projects have included explorations of local history.
- For those wishing to teach in public schools, Coastal offers a Master of Arts in Teaching program that certifies history majors to teach at the secondary level.
