Accessibility and Disability Services

- Disabilities can be Learning, Psychological, and Physical.
- Disabilities must be documented through a full assessment completed within the past 3 years
- Services provided:
 - Accommodations
 - Academic Coaching
 - Testing Center
 - Reading Software
 - Self-advocacy

 - Ensure documentation is received
 - Check on progress of completed procedures (follow through)

Student Health Services

Required Immunizations:

- M.M.R. (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - 2 doses required for students born 1957 or later.
 - dose given at age 12 months or later.
 - dose given at least 28 days after first dose.
- Tuberculin skin test (PPD or Mantoux) within the past year for international students from high-risk countries.

Student Health Services *continued*

Required Immunizations (cont.):

- Meningitis Vaccine (proof of vaccination or a signed waiver is required for new resident students under 25 years of age).
- Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Tdap) (Td or Tdap within last 10 years)

Recommended Immunizations:

- Tuberculin skin test (PPD)
- Hepatitis B (3 doses)
- Hepatitis A (2 doses)

Student Health Services *continued*

Recommended Immunizations (cont.)

- Varicella (chicken pox)
- Quadrivalent Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV) (3 doses)
- Influenza (flu)
