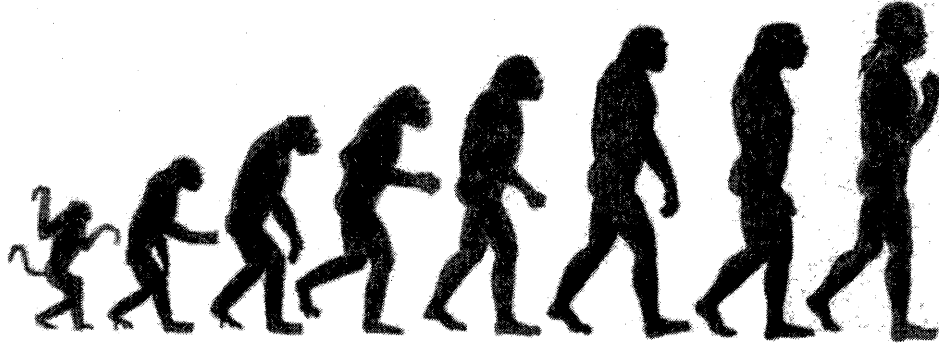

# Primates, People, & Prehistory

## Course Description

As humans, we are the product of biology (inherited) and culture (learned), in all its diverse expressions, over a period of several million years. In this course, we will ask questions about how biocultural evolution worked in the past and how it works today. Focusing on the 'how' aspect of these questions draws on scientific processes and knowledge and informs us scientifically about what we are and how we came to be. This course is an exploration of human origins, human evolution, human prehistory and culture from its less complex forms to early civilizations. It provides an introduction to the concepts, methods, and data of physical, biological, and archaeological anthropology.
