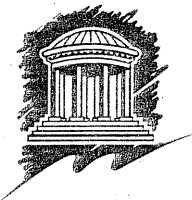
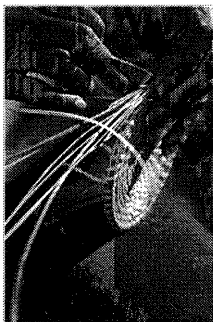


## Course Description
