### MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.) DEGREE IN LEARNING AND TEACHING

Coastal Carolina University is offering a new Master of Education Degree in Learning and Teaching beginning Spring 2010. The program will offer the opportunity for educators to extend their professional knowledge in one of three areas of specialization: Early and Elementary Grades, Instructional Technology, or Literacy. Courses are generally offered in the late afternoons/evenings or online during the academic year and during the day and online in summer sessions.

The M.Ed. in Learning and Teaching requires completion of 30 semester hours of graduate work. Fifteen credit hours are completed in Core Studies in the program and 15 credits are completed in a Specialization area.
