Faculty Profile

In fall 2009 there were 335 full-time employees with faculty rank, which is an increase of 4% from 2008. Of the full-time faculty, 41% were women and 59% men.

Of full-time employees with faculty rank, 83% possessed terminal degrees and 56% were tenured. Of this same group: 20% were professors, 24% associate professors, 34% assistant professors, and 22% instructors/other. Approximately, 66% of FTE students were taught by full-time faculty.

Full-Time Faculty by College and Rank

In fall 2009 each college had at or more than 75% of their full-time teaching staff holding a rank of Assistant Professor or higher. The breakdown for each college is as follows: Wall College of Business (83%), Spadoni College of Education (93%), Edwards College of Humanities and Fine Arts (74%), the College of Natural and Applied Sciences (75%), and the Kimbel Library (100%).
