## **Eligibility**

- In most cases, to be eligible for summer school aid, **you must be enrolled for at least six credit hours (half-time). If you take three hours in one session (Maymester, Summer I or Summer II) and three hours in another session, you will not receive funds until you start your second summer session.**
- To be eligible for summer school aid for the Summer eight-week session (June 7 through July 22, 2010), **you must be enrolled for at least six credit hours.**
- Pell Grant recipients may, in some circumstances, be eligible for Pell Grant funds if enrolled in less than six credit hours. Please refer to the new year-round Pell Guidelines at <http://www.coastal.edu/financialaid/documents/yearroundpell.pdf>.
- **You are not eligible to receive financial aid if you are not enrolled in a degree-seeking program.**
- **Non-Degree Seeking:** A non-degree student is an individual who would like to take courses at Coastal Carolina University for personal and/or personal development. A non-degree seeking student is not a regularly admitted student to the University and **cannot** receive financial aid. These include audit and transient students.

## **Other Documents Needed:**
