- I. Purpose of the Scholarship:** This scholarship is established beginning in Fall 2007 for distribution in the amount of up to \$2,000 to Coastal Carolina University Resident Advisors who participated in hosting international students as a roommate in the International Summer School Program organized through the Wall College of Business Administration. The scholarship may *only* be used to participate in the CBAD 402 Study Abroad in International Business course in the upcoming Maymester program.
- II. Criteria for the Financial Award:** To qualify for the award, the recipient must:
- (1) be a CCU resident advisor who hosted an international student as a roommate through the International Summer School program organized through the Wall College of Business at the beginning the Fall semester in which he or she is making application for the scholarship; and
 - (2) be a student in good standing at CCU with a minimum GPA of 2.5; and
 - (3) be willing and able to participate in the CBAD 402 Study Abroad in International Business course in Maymester of the upcoming year;
 - (4) submit a word processed essay (no longer than 1,200 words) in which he or she does each of the following:
 - (a) articulates how the International Summer School program affected his or her personal growth and development;
 - (b) articulates how he or she incorporated learning from the experience of the International Summer School program into his or her leadership as a resident advisor at CCU; and
 - (c) documents how participation in the CBAD 402 course will meaningfully contribute to his or her educational experience.

The recommendation for the award will be made by a committee composed of the Assistant Dean for International Programs in the Wall College of Business, the CBAD 402 Program Leader, and the Director of Residence Life. The candidate will be selected based on responses provided in the essay, participation in the International Summer Program held in the Fall during which the candidate applies for the scholarship, academic standing, and financial need. The final selection of the candidate will be approved by the University Scholarship Committee. The award is not renewable.
