**Disruptive Behavior**

Threatening and  
persistent

Disruptive, but no immediate threat

**2. Information Discussion**

(Faculty & Student)

- Explain impact of behavior
- Request behavior stops
- Explore alternative to behavior

- Behavior stops
- Possible Academic Consequences

**3. Formal Warning/Official Request**

- Send to student, copy dean, department head and Dean of Students Office

**4. Removal from class and/or clinical setting**

- Police assistance and/or criminal complaint
- Referral to Dean of Students Office

Criminal  
procedures continue

Student Conduct  
procedures continue

Potential  
interim  
suspension

Faculty and Dean, Department Chair and/or SC officer may negotiate terms to allow student's academic progress.

Example: Alternate section, assignment completion, voluntary withdrawal
