Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education AS and A Level Examinations

Coastal Carolina University recognizes the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) as a rigorous and challenging program and will provide credit after the student is enrolled as a baccalaureate degree seeking student. Credit awarded at Coastal Carolina University is dependent upon the scores received on the Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level and Advanced (A) Level examinations. Coastal Carolina University will only award credit for AICE passing grades of A through E on both the AS and A level examinations.

High school students earning the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) may earn college credit for the completion of Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Level and Advanced (A) Level examinations.

Listed below are examples of some of the AS and A level examinations for which Coastal Carolina University may award credit. AICE AS and A level examinations not listed in the provided charts may be awarded credit, but will require departmental review on an individual basis. See your academic advisor to determine how the credit may apply to your academic program.

AS and A Level Examination Results

Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) exam results are released in January (following the November exam series) and August (following the June exam series).

Coastal Carolina University's Office of the Registrar can verify results for most Cambridge AICE examinations instantly via the Results Verification website.

Candidates may also send their results directly to **Coastal Carolina University via the Candidate Results Portal (https://myresults.cie.org.uk/cie-candidate-results/login).** To send results electronically, candidates will first need to register using their ID and secret number.

Once registered, the candidate may simply log in, click "send my results," and select Coastal Carolina University.
