- Students have the option to take a foreign language placement test. The results will require either 6 hours of a foreign (2) language in sequence or 3 hours of a foreign language at the 130 level or higher.
- In addition to enrolling in PDA 100: Building Your Business Portfolio every semester, all business majors must (3) complete 9 approved Professional Development Activities (PDAs) as part of their graduation requirement.
