- (1) Students must take a math placement test. MATH 130/130I (with a C or better) may be required prior to MATH 132
- (2) Students have the option to take a foreign language placement test. The results will require either 6 hours of a foreign language in sequence or 3 hours of a foreign language at the 130 level or higher.
- (3) In addition to enrolling in PDA 100: Building Your Business Portfolio every semester, all business majors must complete 9 approved Professional Development Activities (PDAs) as part of their graduation requirement. A list of approved PDAs can be found at www.coastal.edu/business.
- (4) **Please see reverse side for University Core Curriculum.** You will see what classes will satisfy each requirement.
- (5) Completion of CBAD 120 will also satisfy the Global Studies Awareness requirement within the core.
- (6) Select from any 300 or 400 level Economics Course
- (7) These are free electives that may be selected from any college of the university (this includes foreign language at the 110, 111, or 120 levels, MATH 130 or 130I, and MATH 131)
- (8) Courses at 300 level or above chosen in consultation with your academic advisor.
