What does the Outdoor Center have to offer?

The Outdoor Center is located in the HTC Student Recreation and Convocation Center on campus. It has a wide variety of equipment and programs for little or no cost to students, faculty and staff of CCU. Rent kayaks, paddle boards, camping or fishing gear, bikes and more!

How do I rent gear from the Outdoor Center?

Step 1: Stop by the Outdoor Center with **TWO** forms of ID on the day you wish to rent.

Step 2: Select how many days you wish to rent the equipment; then complete and sign a rental agreement.

Step 3: Pay for your rental. We accept cash, check, credit (MasterCard & Visa) and CINO cash.

Step 4: Take your rented gear on an adventure and return it on the due date assigned. Late fees apply for late returns.

How long can I rent gear for?

There are three lengths of rental periods for renting gear in the Outdoor Center:

Day: (1 overnight)

Weekend: (2 nights)

Week Long: (3 to 7 nights) Not available for kayaks and paddle boards.

Rental Fees vary for each item and rental period.
