## COSTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

All freshman applicants are automatically considered for percentage-based merit awards ranging from 15% to 60% of tuition and fees. The percentage-based system means that award amounts will increase to match any increase in tuition. Awards are also good for four years of continuous study (or eight semesters) as long as the student maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA at CCU, and earns at least 30 credit hours each academic year.
