GLOBAL ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM

The Global Achievement Program (GAP) was developed to support students who are working to complete English proficiency to advance their academic career in the U.S. International students who fall within certain limits below regular admission requirements can be admitted into one of two levels: TEAL (introductory) or COASTAL (intermediate). In both levels, students will get the English language support they need and earn credits toward a bachelor's degree in their chosen program from the first day of classes. Students will also enjoy on-campus housing, activities, and services such as meals, tutoring, health care, and counseling.

Depending on a student's individual level of English proficiency, either one or two semesters will be spent in the GAP before entering CCU courses full-time. Because students earn credit toward a U.S. degree from the beginning of their studies in the program, they will not lengthen the time it takes to graduate with their degree.
