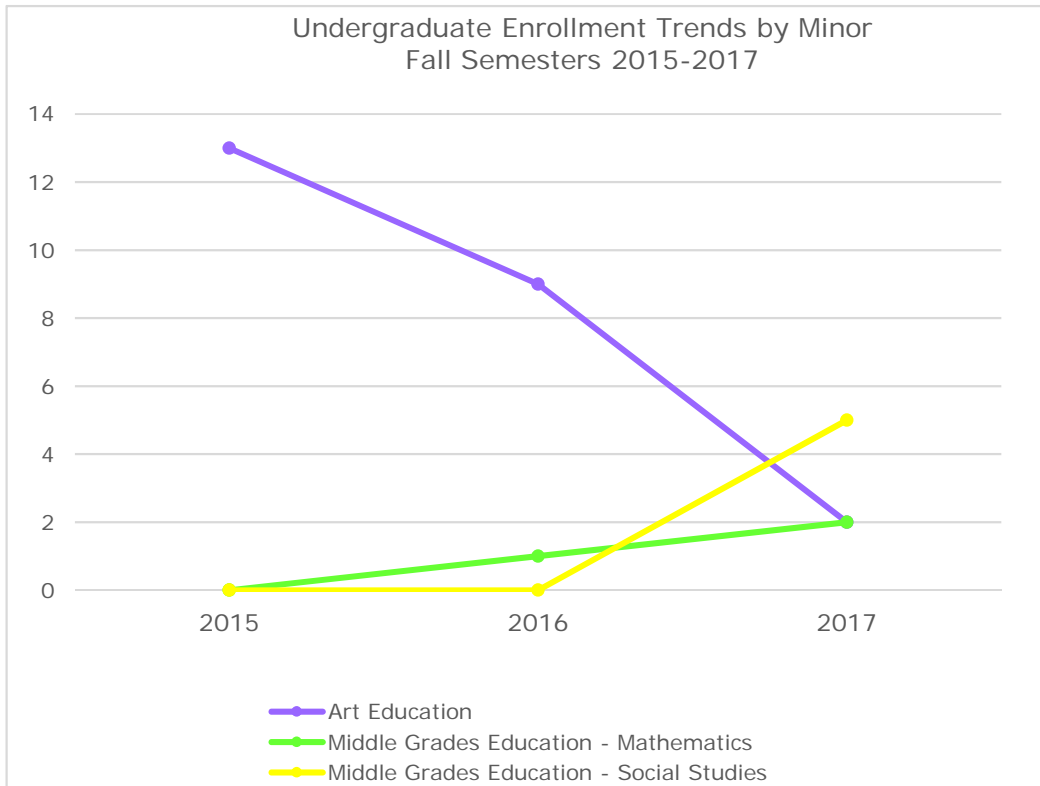

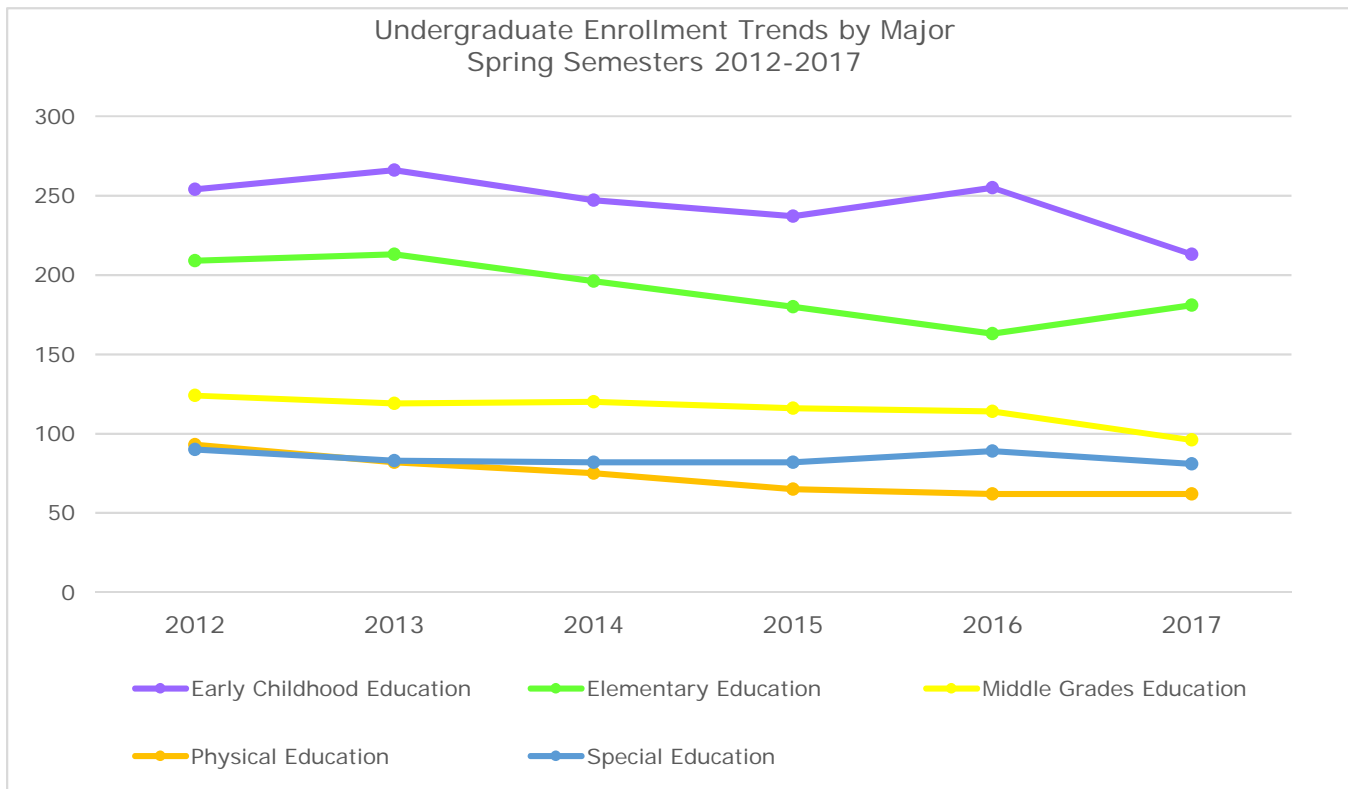

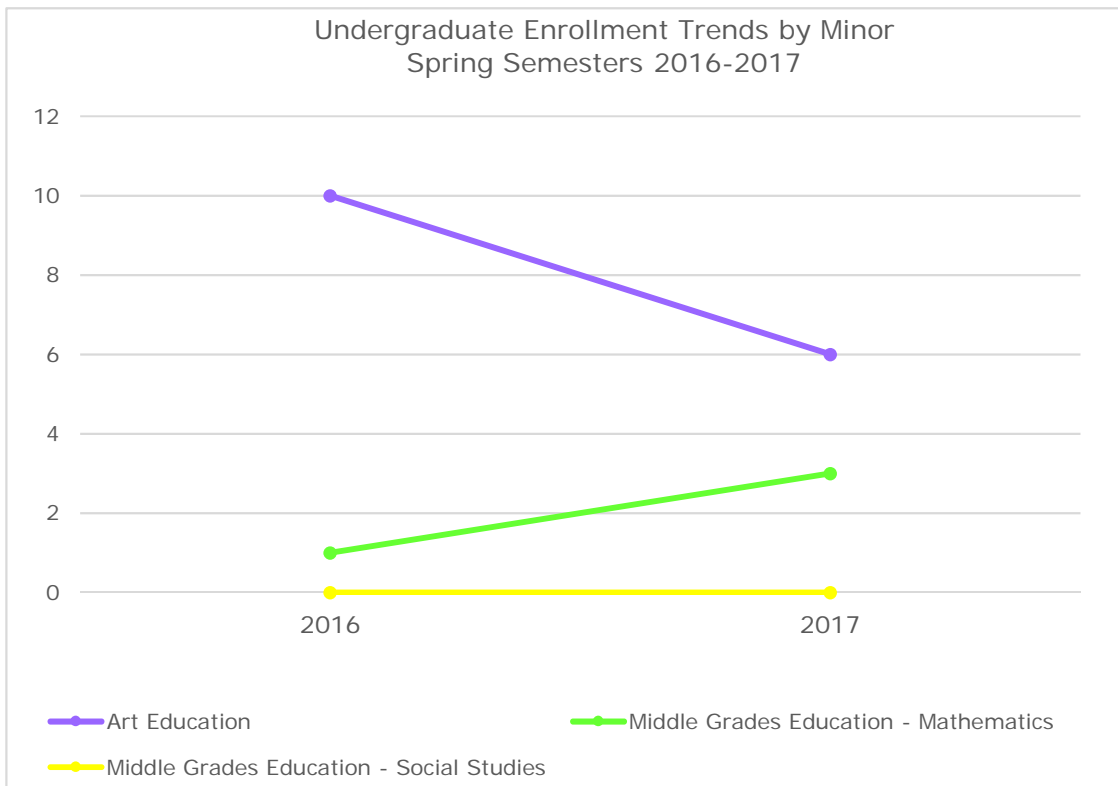

Undergraduate Enrollment Trends by Minor Spring Semesters 2016-2017

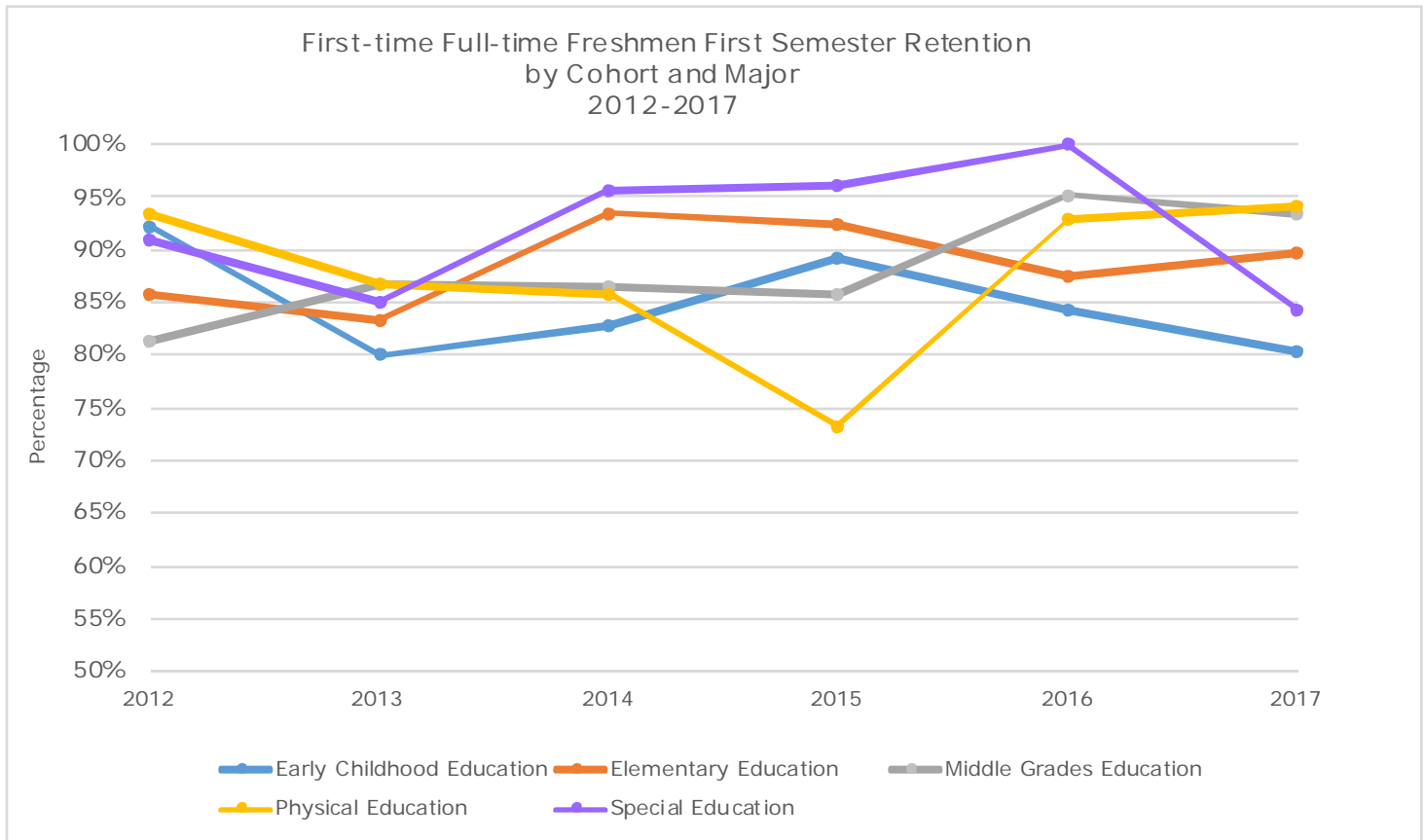

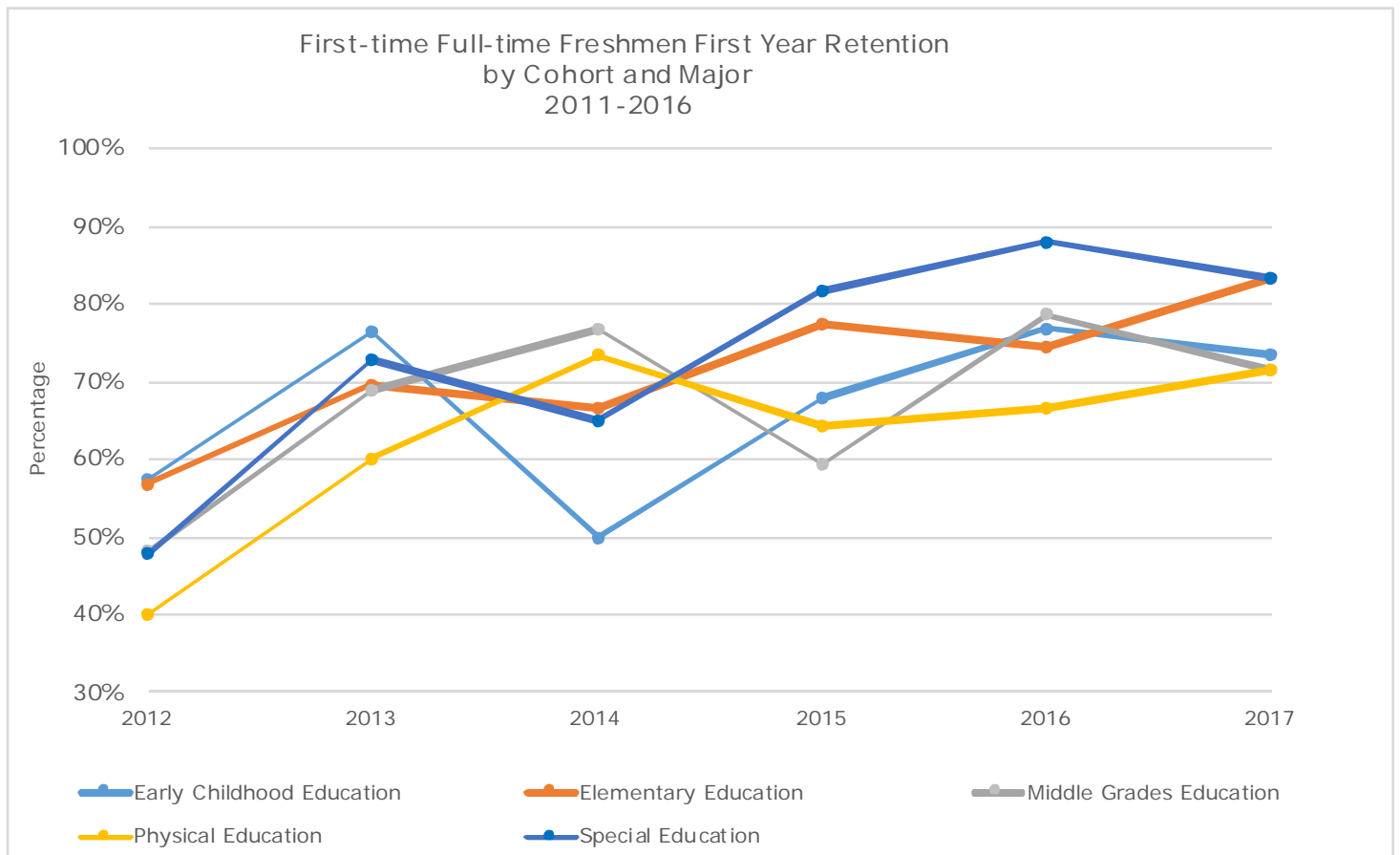

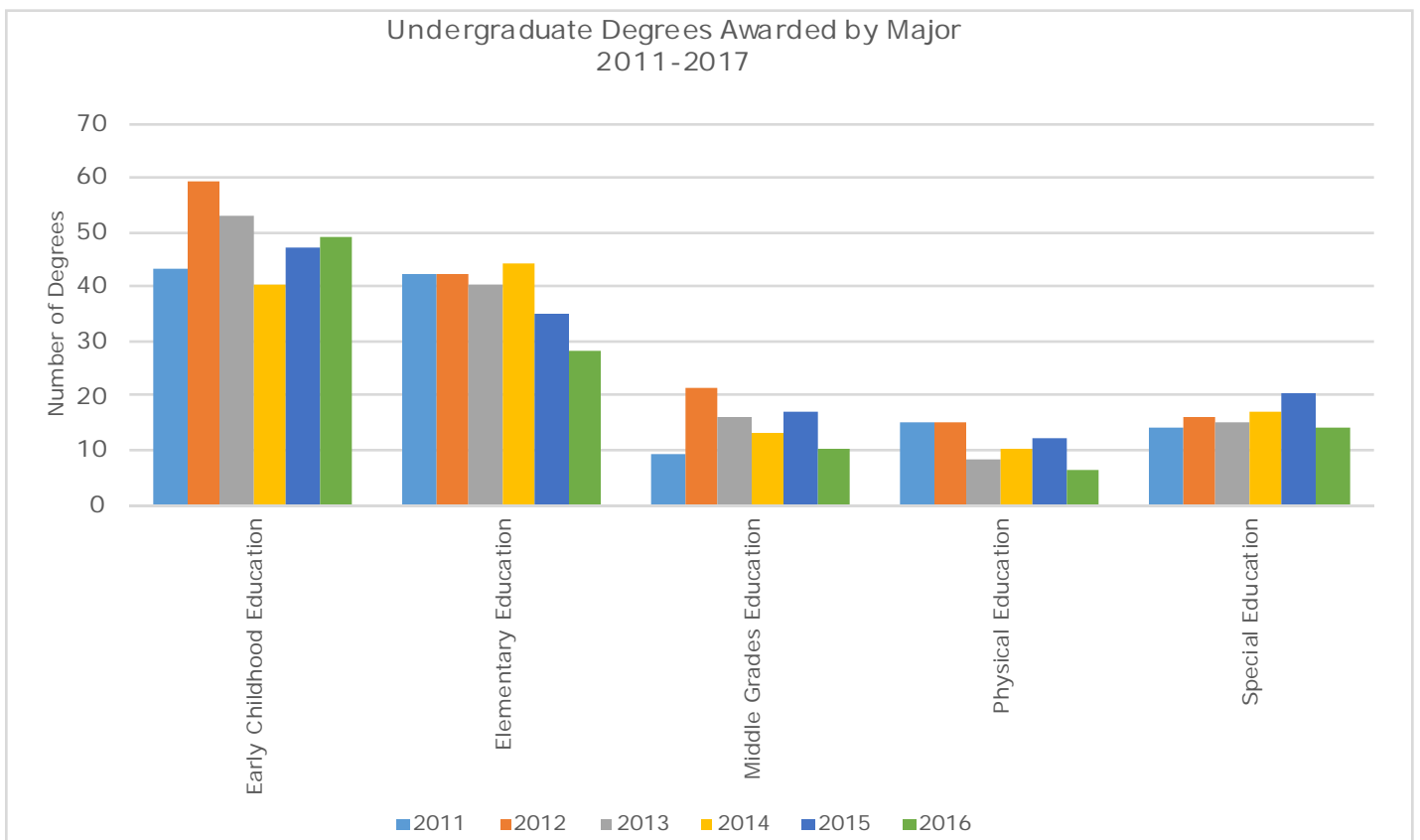

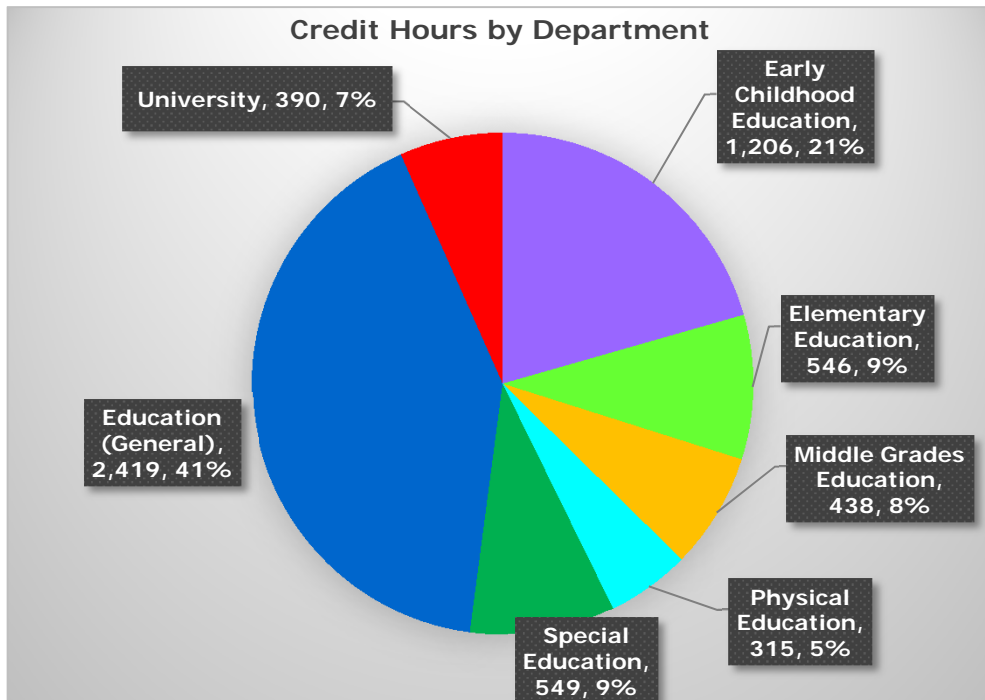

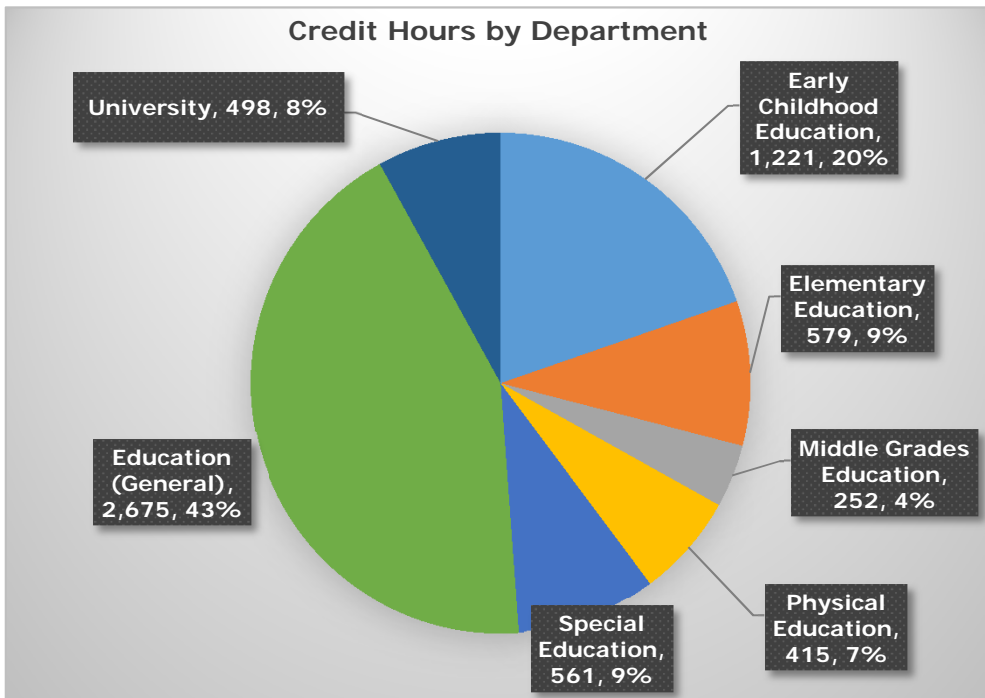


Undergraduate Credit Hour Production by Course Discipline Fall 2016 - Fall 2017
