Chairman Larry Lyles brought the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

**Lyles moved to approve the minutes of the August 7, 2015, Government Affairs Committee meeting, and Sam Frink seconded. The minutes were approved.**

**Stacie requested approval to seek an additional \$4M in General Funds (state appropriations) for the 2016-2017 budget on behalf of in-state students (Motion 15-52).**

President David DeCenzo stated that on October 6, he will be participating in discussions with the House of Education Committee regarding the feasibility of a state Board of Regents.

Congressman Tom Rice has asked DeCenzo what he could do for Coastal Carolina University. DeCenzo responded that a pedestrian bridge over 544 was greatly needed. Rice's staff found that there were federal monies given to each state for this purpose. A conference call was held with DeCenzo, Rice, County Council Chairman Mark Lazarus, and D.O.T. chairman. The

Federal government will be paying for a feasibility study to see what is needed, and the best location.
