ADMITTANCE TO THE PROGRAM:



- Graduate school requirements:
 Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 in content AND one of the following:
 - 1. Minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.75
 - 2. GRE minimum score of 286 (146 verbal and 140 quantitative)
 - 3. MAT minimum score of 388



- 30 semester hours in mathematics with a grade of C or better, including:
 - Calculus (I, II, and III)
 - Linear Algebra
 - Abtract Algebra
 - Geometry (Euclidean and Non-Euclidean)
 - Discrete Mathematics
 - Statistics
 - Applied Mathematics
 - Elementary Computer Programming
