## ADMITTANCE TO THE PROGRAM:



- Graduate school requirements:
  Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 in content AND one of the following:
  - 1. Minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.75
  - 2. GRE minimum score of 286 (146 verbal and 140 quantitative)
  - 3. MAT minimum score of 388



- M.A.T. science candidates must have completed the following courses with a grade of C or better. Candidates must complete five out of the six lecture or lab courses in order to be eligible for admission into M.A.T. program:
  - General Biology I and General Biology I Lab
  - General Biology II and General Biology II Lab
  - General Chemistry I and General Chemistry I Lab
  - General Chemistry II and General Chemistry II Lab
  - General Physics I and General Physics I Lab
  - General Physics II and General Physics II Lab
