### **Information for Obtaining Test Scores**

If your GPA is below 3.25 then you may provide official test scores from the SAT, ACT or GRE (for graduate students) to qualify for the TEACH Grant. Your test scores must be in the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile of the national test scores to qualify under this method.

A student must self-report this information to Financial Aid & Scholarships. Coastal Carolina University's Office of Admissions does not record the percentile records on file with your scores.
