- 3) The total amount of funds disbursed during the quarter ending June 30, 2020 was \$5,027,174.
- 4) The estimated number of students eligible for the quarter was 6,868.
- 5) The number of students who received grants during the quarter was 6,868.
- 6) The methodology used to determine funding was as follows:
 - Qualified students that were enrolled as of the last day of classes for Spring 2020 and incurred
 expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19 were identified and
 awarded emergency grants on May 7th, 2020.
 - \$497,274 was reserved for eligible students to apply for additional funding based on higher incurred expenses during two application cycles (May 8th, 2020 May 29th, 2020 and June 15th, 2020 June 19th, 2020). The applications were reviewed by the University's Benevolence fund committee and eligible students were awarded based on need, exhausting all CARES Act HEERF funding.
 - Students who are not eligible for Title IV funding were not eligible for funding from the CARES
 - Students who were enrolled only in online classes prior to March 13 were not eligible for funding.
 - Students with the greatest documented need using the Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be prioritized. Individual disbursement amounts varied by student dependent on levels of financial need, as defined by Title IV regulations.
 - CCU Financial Aid & Scholarships verified eligibility in accordance with the CARES Act.

Amount: Initial block grant awards to each student were determined by the chart below. Additional funding from the approved applications varied by student and was determined by the benevolence committee based on expressed need due to COVID-related expenses.
