This virtual summer program will be taught through a series of workshops by professors from the Wall College of Business at Coastal Carolina University. The 90 minutes workshops will start at 8:30 and 11:00 am Eastern Standard Time on Monday through Friday (14:30 and 17:00 Central European Time).

Students will learn about:

Students will work on engaging assignments in virtual global teams together with students the U.S. and from various global partner universities. Each virtual team will work on a case study for a company and will create a consulting report for that company. At the end of the program the teams will present their reports to a panel of professors. Students who complete the program will have a virtual graduation and receive a certificate with an American grade and the grade in percent.
