Coastal Carolina University requests the closure of the Undergraduate Certificate in Applied Ethics.

The elimination of the undergraduate certificate was initiated by faculty due to historically low to no enrollment in the program. Faculty members, program coordinators, and the Dean's office were included in the conversations. The department is considering an applied ethics minor or concentration in the Philosophy major as a better option for students.

The two students currently enrolled in the certificate program were informed via email about the closure of the program and were told they would be able to finish the program. All courses required for the certificate are part of other programs in the department. The courses needed are part of the certificate and will continue to be taught in other programs. Students currently enrolled in the certificate will be able to complete the certificate without any disruption or additional costs.

No faculty or staff will be negatively impacted because of this program being discontinued. The faculty teaching the courses for the program support other programs within the department. The staff supporting the applied ethics certificate will continue to support other programs within the department.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Undergraduate Certificate in Applied Ethics.

This letter serves as a notification that Coastal Carolina University has received approval from the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education (SCCHE) to terminate the undergraduate certificate in Applied Ethics effective Fall 2023. No new applications will be accepted into the program as of August 2023.

The certificate program historically has had low enrollment. The department does not find it feasible to maintain the program. Due to this, it was recommended and approved by the faculty and administration for the program to be closed. There are currently two students enrolled in the certificate program. All courses required for the program are offered as part of other programs in the department, therefore no special arrangements will be needed to ensure these students have the ability to complete the certificate program; the courses will continue to be offered in the department after the closure of the program.

Enclosed are the substantive change cover letter, the notification of termination to the SCCHE, the teach-out plan, and the Applied Ethics curriculum.
