




- Two ice storms

- Color




















STERRIT SWAMP CONDUCTIVITY




Annual rain accumulation at Murrells Landing








STERRIT SWAMP pH

NOAA honors New York farmer for 84 years of service as volunteer weather observer

July 21, 2014

When Richard G. Hendrickson logged his first weather observation for the U.S. Weather Bureau, the precursor to NOAA's <u>National Weather</u> <u>Service</u>, Herbert Hoover occupied the White House. Since then the Bridgehampton, New York, farmer has filed twice daily reports, tallying more than 150,000 individual weather observations - playing a critical role in building our nation's climate history.

As part of the National Weather Service

<u>Cooperative Observer Program</u>, Hendrickson collects data from the weather observing station

on his farm and calls in his observations – temperature, precipitation, wind and any other significant weather factors – to the weather service.

On July 27, Hendrickson, age 101, will receive an award for his long standing service – 84 years – to the nation. Since Hendrickson is first in the history of the program to serve for more than eight decades, the new 80-year service award will be named in his honor.
