



Policy Title:	College Requirements for Academic Advisory

SUMMARY:

Students who are placed on academic advisory, as defined in the Coastal Carolina University Catalog, must complete the requirements set forth by their academic college. Modifications to college specific policies must be approved by the Academic Affairs Committee, Faculty Senate and the Provost.

POLICY:

I. POLICY

Students who are placed on academic advisory, as defined in the Coastal Carolina University Catalog, and have earned 30 or more credit hours must complete the requirements set forth by their academic college in addition to the requirements that are listed in the Coastal Carolina University Catalog. Failure to complete these requirements in the semester in which they are assigned could result in a student remaining on academic advisory, regardless of their earned semester and cumulative GPAs. Students who have earned less than 30 credit hours and are on academic advisory must comply with ACAD-140. College-specific policies are developed by the Office of the Dean of each academic college. Modifications to college specific policies must be approved by the Academic Affairs Committee, Faculty Senate and the provost.

A. Wall College of Business

Business students who have earned 30 or more credit hours, including all business pre-majors and undeclared business majors, and are placed on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:

1. Attend an Academic Success Seminar, in-person or virtual, conducted by a representative of the Dean’s Office. .
2. Meet with the Director of Student Success and Transition following the Academic Success Seminar to create an academic and career action plan to include appropriate tutoring and academic resource use as well as discuss appropriate Professional Development Activities.

- B. Spadoni College of Education and Social Sciences
Education and Social Science students who have earned 30 or more credit hours, including all pre-majors and undeclared majors, and are placed on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:
1. Attend an Academic Success Seminar conducted by a representative of the Dean's Office.
 2. Meet with Student Success Coordinator following the Student Success Seminar to create an academic and career action plan.

- C. Edwards College of Humanities and Fine Arts
Humanities and Fine Arts students who have earned 30 or more credit hours and are on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:
1. Attend an Academic Success Seminar conducted by a representative of the Dean's Office.
 2. Attend at least one student success event with the Director of Student Success, Recruitment, and Career Transition in the Edwards College of Humanities and Fine Arts.

In addition, students on academic advisory are encouraged to enroll in HFA 133: *Mindset for Academic Success*.

- D. Gupta College of Science
Science students who have earned 30 or more credit hours and are on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:
1. Complete a GCOS academic success workshop.
 2. Meet with the Director of Student Success & Persistence at least once each semester for each semester on academic advisory.

In addition, students on academic advisory are encouraged to enroll in UNIV 105S: *Academic Improvement Hour*.

- E. CMC College of Health and Human Performance
Health and Human Performance students who have earned 30 or more credit hours and are on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:
1. Attend an Academic Success Workshop or attend the Dean's Academic Success Seminar.
 2. Complete an individual Action Plan via Moodle as outlined by their assigned Academic Success Advisor.
 3. Meet with their assigned Academic Success Advisor at least once each semester for each semester on academic advisory.

F. HTC Honors College

Honors students who have earned 30 or more credit hours and are on academic advisory must complete the following college specific requirements:

1. Attend an Academic Success Seminar conducted by a representative of the Dean's Office.

G. College of Graduate & Continuing Studies

Bachelors of Professional Studies students who have earned 30 or more credit hours and are placed on academic advisory have no additional requirements beyond university policy.
