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THE PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Science in health administration completion program builds on knowledge gained in entry-level health professional programs and provides the advanced knowledge, values and critical judgement skills needed to assume leadership and management roles in health care settings.

All courses in the program are delivered in a distance learning format using the Moodle™ online learning system (high-speed internet required).

Tracks are offered for full-time and part-time degree completion. Students graduate prepared for admission to advanced degree programs such as the Master of Business Administration (MBA) or the Master of Health Administration (MHA).

AREAS OF STUDY

Students in this program study health data analysis and visualization, decision-making with dashboards, health policy, health care marketing, managing health care organizations, medical ethics, and human resource management.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

OPTION 1: Applicants must possess either an Associate of Applied Science or a bachelor's degree with a certification or license in an allied health field. Students who enroll in the program through this entry point will receive up to 45 hours of credit for courses related to the health science certification or license.

OPTION 2: Applicants must possess either an Associate of Science, Associate of Arts, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts degree (no health science certification/license required). Students who enroll in the program through this entry point will need to select five classes from an array of designated public health courses in addition to major course requirements.
