Application Instructions - How to Apply

Please carefully read each of the following application descriptions and then on the **Academic Plans** page, please select the application type that best fits your enrollment plans.

Freshman Application:

- Early Decision: Apply by Oct. 15; notification by Dec. 1; enrollment required by Jan. 15.
- Early Action: Apply by Nov. 15; notification by Dec. 15; enrollment required by May 1.
- Regular Decision: Apply by Feb. 1; notification by March 1; enrollment required by May 1.

You will apply as a freshman applicant if you:

- Have not yet graduated high school, or have earned a GED, or are completing a post-graduate (5th) year of high school.
- Have not taken any college classes between the time you graduated high school, earned your GED, or completed a post-graduate year, and now.
- Note: If you took college-level classes while still in high school, dual enrollment, you are considered a freshman applicant.

Transfer Application:

You will apply as a transfer applicant if you:

- Have taken any college classes since graduating high school, earning a GED, or completing a post-graduate year of high school, regardless of whether you earned college credit.
- College classes include any community/technical college, trade school, two-year or four-year college courses, and/or military service with a Joint Services Transcript (JST).

Second-Degree Application:

You will apply as a second-degree applicant if you:

- Have already earned a bachelor's degree from Coastal Carolina University and are interested in earning a second bachelor's degree.
- Have already earned a bachelor's degree from any accredited four-year college/university, and I am interested in earning a second bachelor's from Coastal Carolina University.

Readmit Application:

You will apply as a readmit applicant if you:

• Were previously enrolled at Coastal Carolina University as a degree-seeking student and have been away from the university for a full semester (fall or spring).

Non-Degree Application:

You will apply as a non-degree applicant if you:

- Are interested in taking classes at Coastal Carolina University but not planning on earning a degree.
- Non-degree applicants cannot take more than 18 credits in this status, must apply each term, and cannot apply for financial aid.
- The non-degree student classifications are listed below:
 - Transient (Visiting) Student: A transient student is enrolled at another institution but plans to take courses at CCU. Please note you are responsible for securing approval from the academic dean or registrar at your "home" institution to ensure that the courses will transfer back to that institution.
 - o **Adult Learner:** Adult learners are non-degree-seeking applicants who seek to enroll in courses for personal or professional enhancement and who are at least 22 years old.
 - Pre-College High School Student: High achieving rising high school seniors may be eligible to begin college studies, on a course availability basis, while concurrently enrolled in high school. Pre-college applicants must provide a high school transcript with a minimum B+ average through the junior year in a college preparatory program and acceptable standardized test scores (if applicable), along with a letter of recommendation of a high school counselor or principal.
 - Senior Citizen: Senior Citizens (age 60 or older) who meet <u>South Carolina residency</u> requirements may be eligible to attend classes on a space availability basis without the payment of tuition (excludes required course fees) provided the applicant meets the regular admission requirements and other standards of the University. Senior citizens may register for classes under the fee tuition provision the day prior to the first day of classes for the current term.

Military

Documentation will be required in all cases to support this claim. South Carolina residents who change their state of legal residence while in the military lose their South Carolina resident status for tuition and fee purposes.

Members of the United States Armed Forces who are permanently assigned in South Carolina on active duty and their dependents are eligible to pay instate tuition and fees.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a covered individual enrolled in a public institution of higher education and receiving education assistance under Chapters 30, 31 and 33, Title 38 of the United States Code is entitled to pay in-state tuition and fees without regard to the length of time the covered individual has resided in this state.
